**GENERAL INFORMATION, ENTRY FEES AND EVENT RULES**

Entry fees include a \$4.50 AKC Recording Fee for every dog entered in the trial.

**Regular Obedience Classes:** Novice Class A/B, Open Class A/B, Utility Class A/B  
**Alternative Title Obedience Classes:** Preferred- Utility, Preferred-Open, Preferred- Novice  
**Optional Titling Classes:** Beginner Novice A/B, Grad Novice, Grad Open, UDX.

**Regular Rally Classes:** Novice A/B, Rally Intermediate, Rally Advanced A/B, Rally Excellent A/B, Rally Master, Rally Choice, RAE, RACH.

**Please Keep the Same Armband for the Entire Day/Trials.**

Judging begins at 8:00 a.m. Friday and Saturday. Judging begins at 9:00 a.m. Sunday. Judges are limited to 8 hours of combined judging per day. Judge may take her lunch or other breaks at her discretion.

**Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible after entries close.** If exhibitor has not received acknowledgement in a timely manner, please notify the Trial Secretary at [KKCObedience@outlook.com](mailto:KKCObedience@outlook.com)

Make all checks and money orders payable to: **Kenai Kennel Club**. Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. NO ENTRY shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. A fee of \$25 will be charged for any returned check.

**Entries** will close on April 8, 2026, **or when the numerical limit or limits have been reached even if closing date has not been reached.** No entry(s) shall be added after the closing time and date specified in the premium list. By providing an email address on the entry form, you agree to electronic correspondence for confirmation letter and judging program.

**A wait list** will be offered to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to April 8, 2026. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing on April 8, 2026.

**Entry fees** shall not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Notice that the club may cancel the event due to extreme weather conditions. Overpayments of fees \$10 or less will be considered a donation to the club and will not be returned.

**Bitches in season:** Bitches that come in season after the closing date of the obedience trial may have all but **\$10.00 per day** of the entry fee refunded upon receipt by the trial secretary of a veterinarian certificate prior to the beginning hour of judging. A written statement must be submitted in writing to trial secretary prior to 30 minutes before judging.

**Injures or Death:** Dogs that cannot compete due to an injury will be given a partial refund for all but \$10.00 per day entry. For injured dogs, a signed letter from a vet must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start of judging on the first day of the trial. In the event of a deceased dog, notification (email or written) must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than the start time on the date of the trial and a full refund will be given.

**Exhibitors** should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

It is the responsibility of the person submitting the entry form to ensure accuracy of data on the entry form. In the event of errors or cancellation, no refund will be given after the published closing date. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience/Rally Regulations Ch.1 Sec. 16. Transfers must be submitted at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial for which the transfer is being requested.

## **EVENT RULES**

**All Dogs** shall be held on leash except when in the Obedience Ring. There shall be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises. The use of corrective devices is strictly prohibited on show grounds.

Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities or building parking regulations.

**Exhibitors and Handlers** will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and for cleaning up after their dogs.

**Judges are Not Required** to for any dog holding up a class. Owners and handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. Dogs should be present with ample time before their scheduled judging.

**THE TRIAL COMMITTEE** will use due diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in the show.

**THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD** is the responsibility of the exhibitor, who must exercise control and restraint over the child while the child is on the show premises. Failure to do so will result in action by the Trial Committee.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
